CONDUCT

Students who participate in competitive athletics at Holland Township School are representatives of our school and community. Each participant is expected to conduct herself with respect toward fellow teammates, coaches, opponents, officials, etc. Insubordination to authority or bullying of peers **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED**. First infraction of our conduct policy will result in decreased playing time. Second infraction will result in a phone call to the parent/guardian and benching. Any subsequent infraction will result in dismissal from the team.

ABSENCE/TARDINESS

Practices are held from 3:35-5pm. Each player is expected to be on the court ready to play at 3:35 SHARP. Initial absence/tardiness will result in a warning. Any absence/tardiness following will result in decreased playing time. Excusable absences from practice and games include illness, medical appointments, pre-approved school functions, or family emergency. Any other absence/tardiness will be handled at the coach's discretion.

GAME DAYS

Team members who are absent from school on the day of a game will not be allowed to participate. Pick up times for home and away games will be announced a day prior to each contest. Each player should be picked up from practice by 5pm. Players who travel home from away games with parent/guardian must have their parent/guardian sign them out before leaving. Players who leave with anyone other than their own parent/guardian must have a note of permission from their parent/guardian stating who they will be leaving with. PLAYING TIME

Playing time is earned, not entitled. Interscholastic athletics are competitive and a strong emphasis must be placed on merit and accountability. The coaching staff will do its best to accommodate each player but equal playing time is **NOT** guaranteed.

OBLIGATIONS

Holland Basketball Team members are required to pay a \$_____ transportation fee to cover busing expenses. Each player is responsible for returning their uniform and pinnie at the conclusion of the season. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action consistent with HTS administrative policy.
