

AHERA/RIGHT-TO-KNOW NOTIFICATION

To: All Employees and Building Occupants or Their Legal Guardians

Pursuant to AHERA (Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act) Regulations, all employees and building occupants or their legal guardians are to be informed annually about the status of and activities relating to asbestos containing building materials in Holland Township School.

In compliance with those regulations, during the school year 1988-89, the Township Board of Education employed a certified consulting firm to identify, inspect and assess all asbestos containing materials in the building and develop a management plan for dealing with them. The certified consultants conducted the 2019-2022 three-year re-inspection of the facility and updated the management plan. The management plan is available for review by employees and building occupants or their legal guardians, by appointment in the Board of Education office, during regular office hours.

Pursuant to the New Jersey Right-to-Know Law, the Holland Township School maintains a file of Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for all hazardous sub-stances used for instructional and non-instructional purposes. This information is available for public inspection as required by law.
