For 1st and 2nd year ski/snowboard students must take 5 lessons. Students who have been in Holland School Ski/Snowboard Club for two years, may select the 3 lesson option.

You will need to order a helmet for \$65 if you do not have one, otherwise you will need to pay \$15 for a day's rental of a helmet.

DMP (Discount Meal Plan) for only \$54.00 ... created for members looking to save a few bucks and tired of packing dinner

The plan includes 6 meal vouchers redeemable in the cafeteria cafeteria and offering a choice of a one hot sandwich (hot dog, hamburger or cheeseburger or chicken sandwich) or tossed garden salad, plus French Fries, plus a medium fountain drink

Important PLEASE READ

- 1. Skiers/snowboarders must follow the skier's code of conduct at all times.*
- 2. Appropriate clothes must be worn to protect the skier/snowboarder from cold and wetness, including hat and gloves. Helmet is mandatory.*
- 3. If a student misses a trip, money cannot be refunded. Shawnee will issue a voucher which can be redeemed by the student on his/her own time, during any weekday evening of the 2015 ski/snowboard season.*
- 4. All skiers/snowboarders must take lessons regardless of ability. Even experts can learn something.*
- 5. **VERY IMPORTANT!** All students must be on the bus at the time assigned, ready to return home. All students should have a watch and keep track of time. The bus will leave Holland School at 3:15pm and leave Shawnee at 8:05 pm sharp. We should arrive at the school by 9:20pm. Parents are asked to be at the school by 9:15pm, waiting for their children to arrive.*

Students that are picked up late will not be allowed to ride the bus the next trip.

- 1. Students should stop skiing/snowboarding at 7:45 in order to be on the bus by 8:00pm. Students who return to the bus late face the possibility of losing their privileges for the next trip.*
- 2. Small snack and water bottle are allowed on the bus ride to or from Shawnee. Students who break this rule will not be allowed to ride the bus the next trip.*

Any student who gets caught skiing/snowboarding in closed areas, riding the lift with the safety bar up, or doing anything considered dangerous and/or inappropriate either by the chaperones or Shawnee Mountain will immediately lose his/her privileges with the club for the rest of the year.

1. *Students may carry a cell phone. However, the phone may not be used on the bus for any reason other than to call home when we reach Phillipsburg.*
