School staff was trained at the start of the school year on how to use the new Bleeding Control Kits now located in the hallways near the AEDs. The Stop the Bleed Campaign is a national program hoping to educate the community about how they might stop life-threatening bleeding until medical help arrives. These kits could be used in the event of an accident, natural disaster, or an attack. Many scout leaders and coaches carry tourniquets with them as part of their first aid kit. Be prepared to help yourself and others in the event of an emergency.
